

God Leads, Guides, and Directs You by His Holy Spirit:

- “The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit.” (Jn 3:8)
- “For as many as are led [ago] by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.” (Rom 8:14)
- “I will instruct [saka] you and teach [yarah] you in the way you should go [yalak]; I will guide [yaats] you with My eye.” (Ps 32:8)
- “For You are my rock and my fortress; therefore, for Your name's sake, lead [nachah] me and guide [nahal] me.” (Ps 31:3)
- “The steps of a good man are ordered [kun] by the LORD, and He delights in his way. (Ps 37:23)
- “Commit [galal] your way [derek] to the LORD, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. (Ps 37:5)
- “Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways [derek] acknowledge [yada] Him, and He shall direct [yashar] your paths.” (Prov 3:5-6)
- “A man's heart plans his way, but the LORD directs [kun] his steps [tsaad].” (Prov 16:9)
- “A man's steps [mitsad] are of the LORD” (Prov 20:24)
- “Commit [galal] your works to the LORD, and your thoughts will be established.” (Prov 16:3)
- “The lot is cast into the lap, but its every decision is from the LORD.” (Prov 16:33)
- “Who is the man that fears the LORD? Him shall He teach [yarah] in the way [derek] He chooses [bachar].” (Ps 25:12)
- “Direct [kun] my steps by Your word, and let no iniquity have dominion [shalat/katakurieuo] over me.” (Ps 119:133)
 - “For sin shall not have dominion [kurieuo] over you, for you are not under law but under grace.” (Rom 6:14)
 - “Keep back Your servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion [mashal/katakurieuo] over me.” (Ps 19:13)
 - “Then God blessed them, and God said to them, Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion [radah/katakurieuo] over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.” (Gen 1:28)
- “Now may our God and Father Himself, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way to you.” (1Thes 3:11)
- “And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead [nachah] the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night.” (Ex 13:21)
- “And you shall remember that the LORD your God led [yalak] you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you and test you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.” (Deut 8:2)
- “who led [yalak] you through that great and terrible wilderness, in which were fiery serpents and scorpions and thirsty land where there was no water; who brought water for you out of the flinty rock” (Deut 8:15)
- “And I have led [yalak] you forty years in the wilderness. Your clothes have not worn out on you, and your sandals have not worn out on your feet.” (Deut 29:5)
- “Then the Angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said: I led [alah] you up from Egypt and brought [bow] you to the land of which I swore to your fathers; and I said, I will never break My covenant with you.” (Judg 2:1)
- “I have taught you in the way of wisdom; I have led [darak] you in right paths.” (Prov 4:11)
- “Have you not brought this on yourself, in that you have forsaken the LORD your God when He led [yalak] you in the way?” (Jer 2:17)
- “Also it was I who brought [alah] you up from the land of Egypt, and led you forty years through the wilderness, to possess the land of the Amorite.” (Amos 2:10)
- “Moreover You led [nachah] them by day with a cloudy pillar, and by night with a pillar of fire, to give them light on the road which they should travel.” (Neh 9:12)
- “But He knows the way [derek] that I take; when He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold.” (Job 23:10)
- “For His eyes are on the ways of man, and He sees all his steps [tsaad].” (Job 34:21)
- “For the LORD knows [yada] the way [derek] of the righteous” (Ps 1:6)
- “He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads [nahal] me beside the still waters.” (Ps 23:2)
- “He restores my soul; He leads [nachah] me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.” (Ps 23:3)
- “You led [nachah] Your people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron.” (Ps 77:20)
- “In the daytime also He led [nachah] them with the cloud, and all the night with a light of fire.” (Ps 78:14)
- “And He led [nachah] them on safely, so that they did not fear; but the sea overwhelmed their enemies.” (Ps 87:53)
- “Therefore the LORD will wait, that He may be gracious to you; and therefore He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you. For the LORD is a God of justice; **blessed are all those who wait [chakah] for Him**...Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, **This is the way, walk [yalak] in it, whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left.**” (Isa 30:18,21)

- “Thus says the LORD [Jehovah], your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: I am the LORD your God [Jehovah Elohim], who teaches you **to profit** [yaal], who leads [darak/poreuomai] you by the way you should go.” (Isa 48:17)
- “O LORD, I know the way of man is not in himself; it is not in man who walks to direct [kun] his own steps [tsaad].” (Jer 10:23)
 - “He not only enlightens their eyes, but directs their steps. By his grace he leads them in the way of duty, by his providence he leads them in the way of deliverance. Happy are those that are under such a guidance!” – Matthew Henry
 - “Now an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip, saying, Arise and go [poreuo] toward the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza. This is desert.” (Acts 8:26)
 - “Then the Spirit said to Philip, Go near [proserchomai] and overtake this chariot.” (Acts 8:29)
- “And they did not thirst when He led [yalak] them through the deserts; He caused the waters to flow from the rock for them; He also split the rock, and the waters gushed out.” (Isa 48:21)
- “To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads [exago] them out.” (Jn 10:3)
- “My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow [akoloutheo] Me.” (Jn 10:27)
- “But if you are led [ago] by the Spirit, you are not under the law.” (Gal 5:18)
- “Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring [ago] him with you, for he is useful to me for ministry.” (2Tim 4:11)
